"I'm incredibly excited to begin this new chapter with ASPAN and bring my experience from other nursing associations into this role," said Pomilio. "I'm honored to follow the strong foundation built by Kevin Dill and the dedicated ASPAN staff and look forward to supporting the continued evolution of this vital association."

Pomilio brings two decades of non-profit executive leadership to ASPAN, most recently as the CEO of the American Academy of Ambulatory Care Nursing and the Society of Urologic Nurses and Associates. Previously, he worked as CEO for the American Board of Clinical Social Work as well as the COO for the Society for Cardiovascular Magnetic Resonance. Pete's successful track record working with boards to grow membership, expand educational opportunities, and achieve long-term objectives via strategic planning makes him ideally suited for his new role at ASPAN.



Pomilio holds an M.B.A. from DeVry University's Keller Graduate School of Management and a B.A. in psychology from Rutgers University. He also serves on the Board of Directors of Mid-Atlantic Society of Association Executives and is a Certified Association Executive (CAE). Pete and his family reside in New Jersey, and he will be based at the National Office in Cherry Hill, New Jersey.
