

Clinical Practice: Frequently Asked Question

Q: What is the recommendation from ASPAN on a patient coming from an inpatient floor on a Precedex drip? If we are titrating what is the recommendation for monitoring/ staffing, & if the drip is at threshold, what is the monitoring/staffing for preop holding?

A: Intravenous Dexmedetomidine is frequently used for intubated patients in the intensive care unit for sedation before surgery and intraoperatively. ASPAN does not have a specific recommendation on the use of intravenous Dexmedetomidine for intubated patients transferred to the PACU. It is important to know your state board of registered nursing practice regulations regarding intravenous Dexmedetomidine. In determining guidelines for the use of intravenous Dexmedetomidine in the PACU, collaboration between the PACU staff, the anesthesia department, the pharmacy, and administration is essential to establish clear expectations.
