

Clinical Practice: Frequently Asked Question

Q: What are the recommendations for PACU nurses regarding ACLS and PALS?

A: This is addressed in "Standard III-Staffing and Personnel Management" in the 2019-2020 *Perianesthesia Nursing Standards, Practice Recommendations and Interpretative Statements.* It states:

Phase I

"The perianesthesia registered nurse providing Phase I level of care will maintain a current Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and/or Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) provider status, as appropriate to the patient population served,"¹

Phase II

"It is strongly recommended that the perianesthesia nurse providing Phase II level of care will maintain a current Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and/or Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) or Pediatric Emergency Assessment Recognition and Stabilization (PEARS) provider status, as appropriate to the patient population served."¹
