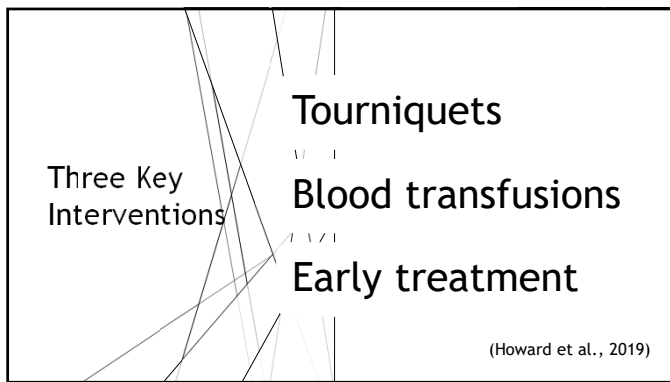
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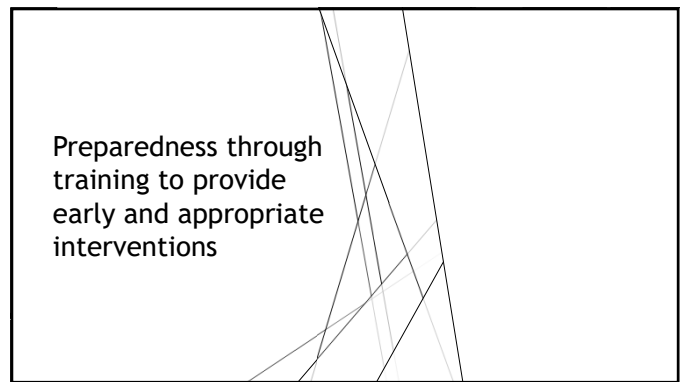
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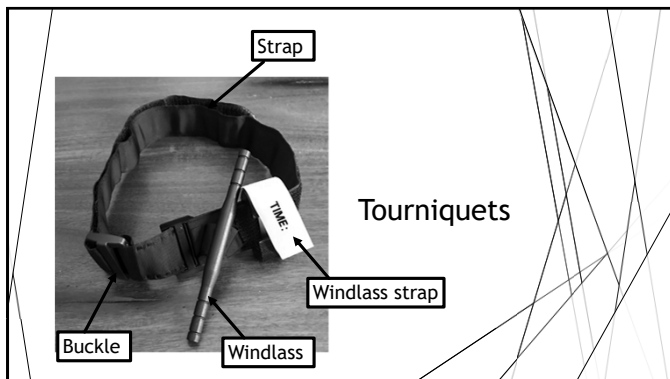
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
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
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### IV Resuscitation

- Cryoprecipitate

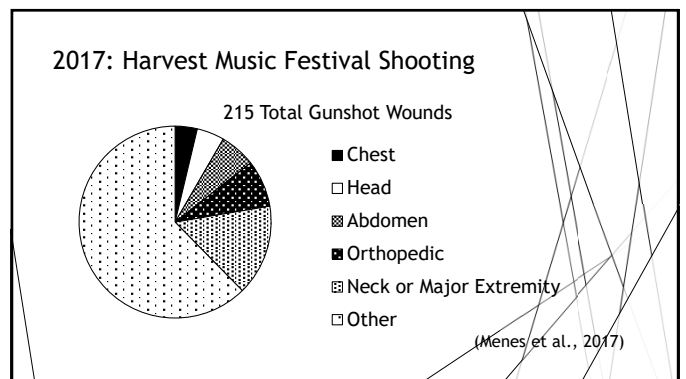
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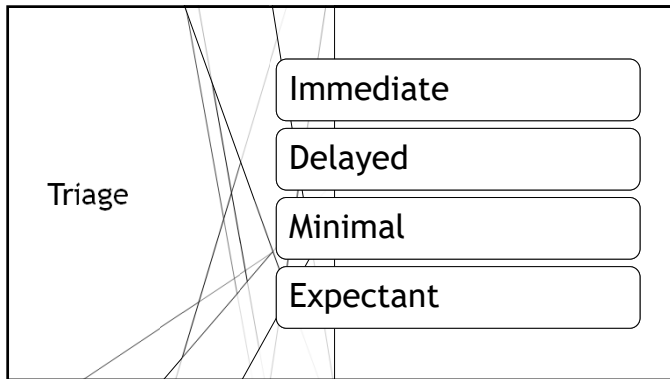
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**GSW to the Left Chest**

- ▶ 84 units of blood products

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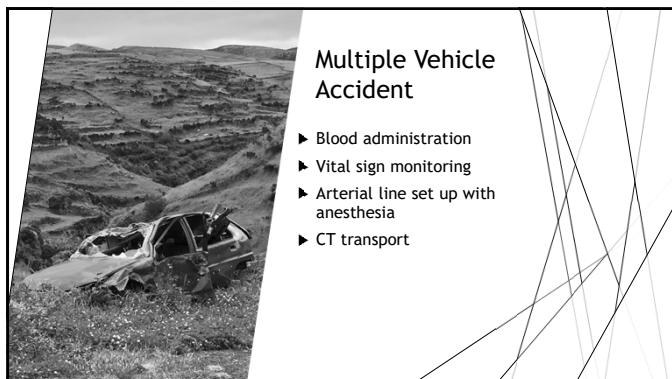
