

# **ASPAN Select Seminars**

ASPAN Select allows components, component districts and component chapters to show one to three prerecorded modules during their meeting or conference. (At this time, only these entities can request ASPAN Select Seminars. All requests must be done through the main component president; not the district or chapter president.)

Components registering to use ASPAN Select will receive ten percent of the net income generated. Reimbursement occurs after the seminar and the money is sent to the component president.

The ASPAN Select request form is on the next page. Please be sure to submit to ASPAN at least 3 months (90 days) in advance of the date of the program. The last day of each month will be the deadline. For example:

September 30<sup>th</sup> for January 2025, October 31<sup>st</sup> for February 2025, November 30<sup>th</sup> for March 2025, etc.

\*\*\*ASPAN has blackout dates that fall around National Conference – 4 weeks before and 3 weeks after conference. ASPAN Select cannot be scheduled between March 29 and May 24 for 2025.

The person named as host/hostess of the ASPAN Select Seminar will be the primary point of contact for this seminar. A security deposit of \$250 is required and will be refunded once the flash drive/video is returned to ASPAN following the seminar. If the flash drive is not returned, you forfeit the security deposit and the 10% return check.

Once the ASPAN Select Seminar is scheduled, the event must be advertised at the component level (e.g., via their website, emails, and social media), using the ASPAN provided flyer only. It will also be advertised on the ASPAN Learn website. Participants will register through ASPAN Learn.

The host will indicate the maximum seating available for the venue and that will be the maximum number of registrations allowed. **A minimum of 5** attendees is required to insure a successful program. Any seminar that does not meet the minimum of 5 attendees by one week prior to the event will be cancelled. Registration for this program is offered on a first come, first served basis (if your seating is limited, encourage attendees to register early). Registration to attend will close 3 business days before the seminar, unless otherwise indicated. On site registrations cannot be accepted.

- **Please note** the following are <u>never</u> permitted at an ASPAN Seminar: Commercial Support, Exhibits, Raffles, Sales, Silent Auctions, Food, etc.
- Audio taping or video taping of any portion of an ASPAN program is **strictly prohibited**.

The individual who is hosting the seminar will be responsible for arranging and all costs associated with:

- 1. All on-site logistics such as meeting room booking, laptop, LCD projector, screen, speakers for the computer and/or sound for the room when necessary (expenses to component).
- 2. A flash drive with the video recording(s) will be mailed to the host.
- 3. At the seminar, the host will present the video(s) for the participants.
- 4. Following the ASPAN Select Seminar, the participants will log into the ASPAN Learn website, complete the online evaluation, and receive their contact hour certificate.
- 5. The flash drive will be returned to ASPAN, within one week, and the security deposit will be refunded.
